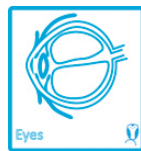


## Ideas

The cards are designed to be flexible to use – do whatever works best for you and your workers. They can be used on their own, in sets or by mixing and matching them to create different scenarios and stories – there are no rules!

**IDEA:** Try mixing and matching the [body @ work cards](#) with some of the prompts and questions in [Talking Points](#).



**IDEA:** Try mixing and matching the [action @ work cards](#) with some of the [body @ work cards](#) to see what people want to talk about.



**IDEA:** Try discussing how the design of a specific piece of [equipment @ work](#) might affect healthy working. You could also ask people to think about the actions they perform when using this equipment using the [action @ work cards](#).



**IDEA:** Try thinking about a situation where the [weather @ work](#) affects people, e.g. what actions are they performing, what equipment is being used? Some [Talking points](#) could also be used to help discussion.



You may decide other ways of [using the @ work cards](#) and, if there is not a card in OWL that shows what you want, you can always make your own @ work card using the [blank @ work](#) card template.

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
